

**Minutes of the review meeting on progress of establishment of Quality Residential ITCs at different locations of the State by the Industries/ PSU who have signed MoU with State Government held on 3<sup>rd</sup> July, 2012 at 11.30 AM in the Conference Hall No-3, near R.D. Department of Odisha Secretariat, Bhubaneswar.**

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The review meeting on progress of establishment of Quality Residential ITCs at different locations of the State by the Industries/PSU signed MoU with State Government was taken by the Chief Secretary, Odisha. The list of Officers and the representatives of Industries / PSUs participated is enclosed at **Annex-"A"**.

Initiating the discussion the Commissioner-Cum- Secretary to Government, E&TE&T Department stated that, the State Government has fixed the target to train 1 million persons during 12<sup>th</sup> Five Year Plan and simultaneously Government of India has given the ambitious target to train about 2.78 Million persons during the period. It is imperative for capacity expansion of Craftsman Training sector in the State to match the target. Out of 26 Industries entered into MoU for establishing quality ITCs in 28 Blocks of the State, 22 have filed applications and issued with provisional permission to go ahead with training activities w.e.f. August, 2012 session.

In his opening remarks, the Chief Secretary mentioned that, skilling more & more youths is the need of the hour and the Industries/PSUs & other stakeholders must participate proactively for skill development of local youths for a mutual benefit. A very small investment on land, infrastructure, quality machineries & trainers by the Industry Houses in establishing and maintaining ITIs at the stipulated locations will definitely yield a positive outcome in long run.

The progress made by the Industries in acquiring land, identifying temporary accommodations, hiring of consultants etc was reviewed precisely on one-to-one basis and the minutes are detailed in the table at **Annex-"B"**.

**The following decisions were taken:**


- (1) The E&TE&T Department will review the progress made by the absentee 7 numbers of MoU signed Companies by 20<sup>th</sup> July, 2012 and report status.
- (2) It was observed that, none of the MoU signed Industries are eligible for NCVT affiliation of different trades for which provisional permission has been issued for August, 2012 session. Accordingly, it was decided that, all of them must identify suitable temporary accommodation and start training activities in the trades (at least one matric and one non-matric) under SCTE&VT, Odisha pattern during August, 2012 session and simultaneously expedite construction activities etc at the MoU

signed locations to make them functional under NCVT pattern w.e.f February, 2013 or latest by August, 2013 session.

(3) The temporary accommodations, preferably unused Government sheds such as defunct PSI units, IDCO industrial sheds may be optimally utilized with required renovation to accommodate the trades applied for. In case of private premises, requisite workshops / class rooms etc. should be raised in a time bound manner. The Principals of ITIs / Polytechnics /GM, DICs will extend support to the Industries for identification of temporary accommodations.

(4) The Collectors concerned may be requested by E&TE&T Department to resolve the local issues on possession of land.
