

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING ON STAKE HOLDERS CONSULTATION FOR THE SKILL DEVELOPMENT STRATEGY FOR THE DISTRICT OF JAJPUR HELD ON 09.04.2012**

A meeting on Stakeholders consultation for skill development strategy for the district of Jajpur was held on 09.4.2012 under the chairmanship of Commissioner-cum- Secretary to govt. Employment and Technical Education and Training Deptt.. The commissioner-cum- Director of Employment & State employment Mission was present. The officials from OMEGA, Officials from Employment Mission and DTE&T were also present. The officials representing various Industries and ITCs of the district present on the occasion are given at **Annexure-A.**

Initiating the discussion, the Commissioner-cum- Secretary to Govt. outlined the importance of creation of the new Department by the Govt. and sought necessary supports from Industries and ITCs in the matter of imparting qualitative training and facilitating placement on completion of training.

Commissioner-cum- Director of Employment stressed the need for proactive approach of Industries for placing the trained youth who fulfill their skill requirements.

Sri Purushottam Kandoi, President, Kalinganagar Industries Association speaking on the occasion outlined the need for imparting quality training as per the skill requirements of the Industries. He also stressed the need for improvement of training infrastructure of ITCs and quality in training delivery.

ITCs participating in the discussion submitted that, they are ready to bring improvements in the training infrastructure and in the training delivery mechanism. But the Industries should facilitate the placement of trained youth.

After elaborate discussions, following decisions were taken:-

- ✓ ITCs will make substantial improvements in their infrastructure including equipments for imparting quality training in a phased manner.
- ✓ Possibilities of recruiting retired defence personnel of the Engineering wing of the Defense Forces as trainers may be explored by ITCs for imparting qualitative training.
- ✓ ITCs should have regular interaction with the local Industries in order to identify their skill requirements.
- ✓ Industries will facilitate Industry exposure visits of students of ITCs and ITCs should work in tandem with the Industries for the same.
- ✓ The President, Kalinganagar Industry Association, Jajpur will submit the skill requirement report of Jajpur district forecasting the manpower requirements of the local industries for next 2-3 years vis-à-vis training facilities available/to be created in consultation with the industries and ITCs. The requirement of modern key equipment as per NCVT syllabus / skill modules beyond NCVT curricula those are needed to make the ITC passed out industry ready should also be incorporated in the report.
- ✓ President, Kalinganagar Industries Association will submit the list of key equipments that need to be installed by ITCs for meeting the skill requirements of Industries.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair.
