**Minutes of the meeting held in the office chamber of Commissioner-Cum-Secretary, Employment & Technical Education & Training Department on 27.03.2012 at 1.00PM to review the vacancy position in OTE&TS Cadre.**

Initiating the discussion commissioner-cum-Secretary desired to know the vacancy position of Principals in different ITIs and Polytechnics. Discussions were made on the following points.

**A. Filling up of the post of Lecturers through OPSC.**

1. In case of 55 posts, no advertisement has been made by OPSC. Prior to the publication of advertisement to fill up the posts, a case was filed by the Resource Persons in the Hon`ble OAT and obtained a stay order on the publication of the advertisement by OPSC, thus, the matter was stalled as such at that stage.
2. In case of 87 posts to be filled up by OPSC through advertisement No.7 of 2010-11, the Hon`ble OAT has ordered as follows. "to formulate a scheme for regularizing such applicants who are contractual RPs in accordance with Resolution No. 31162 dt. 4.11.96 as Lecturers before taking action to advertisement No. 7".
3. In case of 19 promotional vacancies which is 25% of 74, the same has also been stayed by Sri R.K.Rout and others as because their names have not been included in the zone of consideration for filling up the promotional vacancies by way of promotion from Class-III posts to Class-II posts. Steps may be taken to vacate the stay with immediate effect so as to fill up the promotional posts along with the direct recruits.

**B. Filling up of the post of Principals of Engg. Schools and Polytechnics by way of promotion.**

1. The promotion to the post of Principals of Engg. Schools and Polytechnics has been stayed by one Sri Nishakar Mallick, Sr. Lecturer, UCPEs, Berhampur as because he has challenged the gradation list in the court of law.
2. As regards Govt. Polytechnics, 10 posts of Principal have been created so far. 9 out of them belong to Class-I (Inter) and one post belongs to Class-I Jr. At present, 4 Principals are in position out of 9 Class-I (Inter). One of them will retire on 31.3.2012. As a result, 6 posts of Principals in the rank of Class-I (Inter) will remain vacant w.e.f. 01.04.2012. In the mean while, 22 posts of Principals have also been created to man 22 newly created Polytechnics.

To fill up the above vacancies, DPCs are to be convened. But while examining the records, it was ascertained that there is dispute in finalization of the Gradation List. Some of the officers of OTE&TS cadre have gone to the court of law and obtained stay order. It was resolved that since G.A. Department is the nodal Department for advising on Service Conditions, on

receipt of the proposal from the DTE&T, the file will be submitted to G.A. Department for their advice. Once the DPC will be conducted for the post of Principal of Polytechnics, the resultant vacancies will arise in Class-I Jr. and Class-II level. The follow up steps will be taken simultaneously to fill up the Class-I Jr. posts and vacancies in Class-II posts.

After receipt of the advice of the G.A. Department the same shall be placed before the Hon'ble Court to take a view on the pending cases. Expeditious steps shall be taken by the office of the DTE&T to expedite the Writ Appeal filed on this matter in the Hon'ble High Court for vacation of stay.

C. **Regularization of services of Resource Persons engaged against regular post of lecturer through validation Act.**

Resource Persons have obtained a Court order for formulating a scheme for regularization of their services. On receipt of the order of the Hon'ble OAT dated 23.09.2011 in this regard the proposal is under examination and the concurrence of different administrative departments will have to be taken prior to submitting the same for Cabinet approval. The Deputy Director (CDC&FD) was advised to move the Hon'ble Court with a time petition seeking 6 months time more because it involves actions of many Government Departments such as Finance Department, G.A. Department, ST&SC Development Department etc. Till this matter is finalized at Govt. level, no further action can be initiated for recruitment of lecturers through OPSC covered under the advertisement No. 7 of 2010-11 as ordered by the Hon'ble Court. Office of DTE&T will examine the matter having a congruous reading of the OA cases to-gather and submit a proposal to Govt. forth with for going ahead with the recruitment process through OPSC for filling up of 55 posts of lecturer.

D. **Filling up the post of Principal in Govt. ITIs**

It was ascertained that 30 posts of Principals have been created to man the posts of Principal in different Govt. ITIs. The posts of Principal in some of the ITIs have not yet been created. The proposals to that effect will be submitted to the Department for their creation by the office of the DTE&T. Out of 30 Principal posts created so far, 12 Principals are in position. 18 posts of Principal are to be filled up by way of transfer and posting of Class-II officers (lecturers) from OTE&TS cadre. Necessary proposal to that effect may be sent from the office of the DTE&T to the Department immediately

E. **Vacancies in the SCTE&VT**

The post of Controller of Examination in the rank of Class-I (Sr.) is lying vacant at SCTE&VT due to the death of L. K. Mohapatra. the incumbent. Further the post of Vice-Chairman, SCTE&VT will fall vacant w.e.f. 01.05.2012 consequent upon the retirement of Sri A.K. Sahoo. Hence, steps need to be taken expeditiously for filling up the above two posts of Class-I Sr. in OTE&TS cadre by way of promotion from among the Class-I (Inter) officers through DPC.
