

**Proceeding of the 2nd DET-2012 Committee Meeting held on
27.04.2012 in the Conference Hall, ETE&T Department, Odisha,
Niyogan Bhawan, Bhubaneswar.**

At the outset Deputy Director (B&M) welcomed the Chairman and all participants and appraised regarding the implementation of DET-2012 activities by various Institutes. The Commissioner-cum-DTE&T, Odisha insisted upon the smooth conduct of DET-2012 and instructed that in case of doubt the benefit shall be given to the candidates. The Principal, BOSE, Cuttack presented a note regarding preparation of DET-2012 along with the statistics of events for conducting the examination on 13.5.2012. After detailed discussion on distribution of examination materials, creation of Call Centres, deployment of Security for watch and ward of Strong room etc., the Committee resolved the following.

1. Adequate nos. of buffer Centres shall be identified to accommodate the candidates who will apply during the period of extension.

2. Principal, BOSE, Cuttack is requested to publish the result of Lateral Engg. Candidates as earlier as possible so as to start E-counselling in the 1st week of June, 2012.
3. It was decided that the examination materials excluding the Question Booklet carrying trunk shall be distributed in one counter to facilitate the Supervisor & Asst. Supervisor. A minimum of 5 to 6 counters shall be opened to distribute the materials in order to avoid over crowding.
4. The sealed trunks containing Question Booklet shall be kept in a strong room provided with watch and ward round the clock. There shall be arrangement of temporary Guest rooms having fans and water facility for Supervisors and Assistant Supervisors so as to take rest during receipt and return of examination materials. Police personnel from the nearby Police Station may be deployed during the distribution and receipt of examination materials to maintain law and order.
5. MIS for creation of data base of DET examinees and admitted candidates shall be created at BOSE, Cuttack with help of the Service Provider of Pre & Post processing work and NIC. **(Action:- Principal, BOSE, Cuttack)**
6. A Call Centre may be created at BOSE, Cuttack to meet the queries of DET examinees like Roll Nos. and Centres etc. The advertisement to this effect shall be published in the Daily Newspapers mentioning the contact No. of the Call Centres for the awareness of the candidates. The expenditure to this effect shall be made out of DET Fund available at BOSE, Cuttack.
7. The Committee approved the following expenditure.
 - i) Expenditure towards hospitality for Pre & Post Processing work of DET-2012 Rs.1,07,500/- as per the break up submitted by Principal, BOSE, Cuttack vide his letter No.1050, dt.25.4.2012 and purchase of one heavy duty Printer and Scanner for DET activities at BOSE, Cuttack. The expenditure to this effect shall be made out of DET Fund available at BOSE, Cuttack.
 - ii) Hiring charges towards BFTIO Auditorium room of DET-2010 & 2011 for Rs.2, 81,000/-.
8. Principal, BOSE, Cuttack shall ensure that the data base of DET-2012 candidates shall be kept in confidential and secured mode.
9. Admission to NRI seats will be done in the line of OJEE. DTE&T, Odisha shall move to Government in E and TE&T to get the specific order to this effect well in advance for preparation of seat matrix.

The Meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair and all participants.
